2015 ST KILDA ESPLANADE MARKET - SITE RULES AND INFORMATION		Tick
1.	Abide by City of Port Phillip officers instructions	
2.	Adherence to OH&S legislation and regulations is compulsory	
3.	Adequate weights to be used to hold temporary structures down at all times	
4.	Beware of cyclists & pedestrians during set up and secure work areas with barriers as required	
5.	Cash handling to be completed in a secure environment	
6.	Do not block Emergency or other accesses to car parks & private property	
7.	Event site damage cost will be billed to stallholder responsible for area	
8.	4.5 kg Fire extinguishers and fire blankets to be installed at all risk areas (cooking)	
9.	Food safety regulations to be adhered to at all times	
10.	Gas cylinders to be fastened and stored correctly, test LPG hoses and fittings with soapy water bottle	
11.	Gas Safety Checklists to be completed by stallholders immediately on connection ready for INSPECTION	
12.	Electrical leads and appliances to have current test tags attached to leads	
13.	Electrical Leads on ground weather proof, approved items and installed in cable traps/ raised off ground	
14.	Kerbs and drain covers clear of rubbish or stock in case of rain, etc.	
15.	Materials to be stacked flat or fastened to prevent collapse from wind etc	
16.	No hot surfaces such as BBQs, Wok's, accessible to public. Separation between marquee walls cookers	
17.	In case of an emergency please contact 000	
18.	No smoking in or on any of the structures or buildings or where fire hazard exists	
19.	No vehicle is to be left unattended in the event area	
20.	Noise levels to be at a comfortable level (reduce noise level if instructed to by CoPP staff)	
21.	Personal protective equipment to be worn at all times when required	
22.	Products causing excessive waste and cleanup may be withdrawn from sale	
23.	Protect surfaces under cooking equipment and generators to avoid excessive spills	
24.	Respect the instructions of all CoPP staff	
25.	Safety boots (adequate foot wear) to be worn during bump in & out	
26.	Switch boxes to be locked and out of public reach	
27.	Urns and boiling water to be on stable tables and unable to be tipped over	
28.	Vehicles to be driven walking speed with hazard lights on	
29.	Work areas to be cordoned off from public during bump in/out
